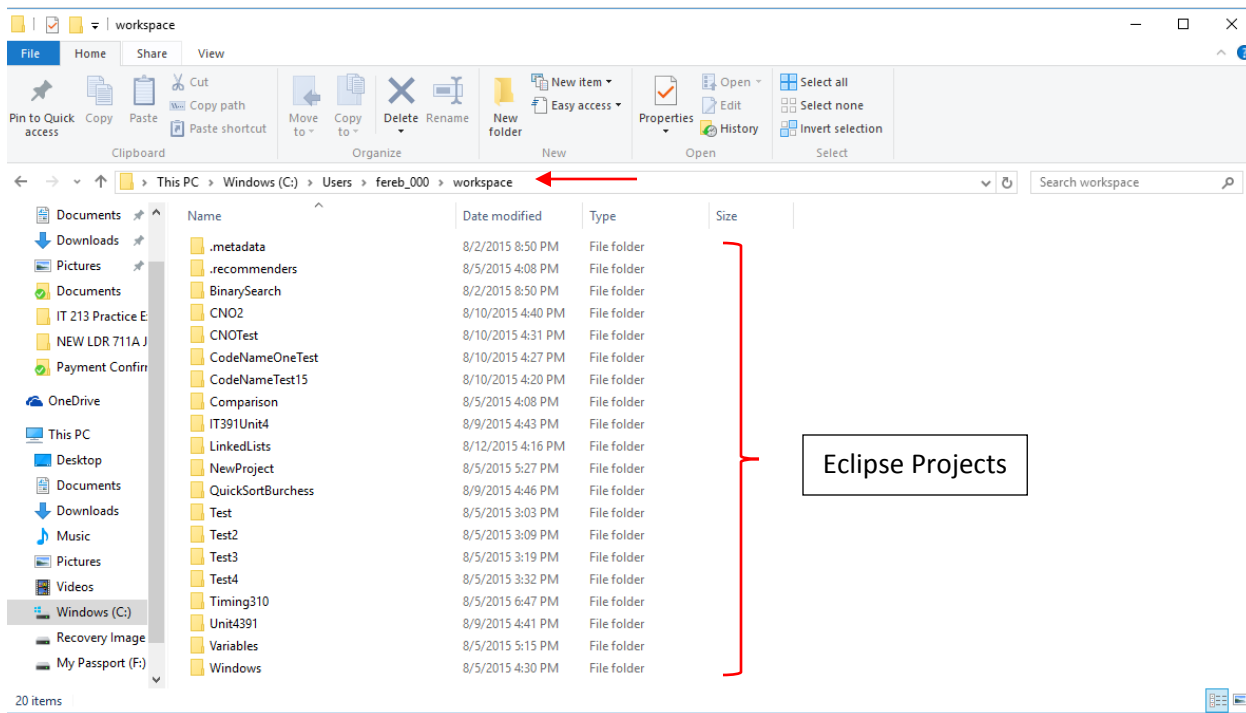


How to Zip Your Eclipse Project Folder

Eclipse projects are saved in your workspace directory (the workspace you enter when you launch Eclipse). This directory is typically found at C:\Users\yourUserName\workspace.

When you open the workspace folder you will see the projects that you have completed in Eclipse.



- Highlight and right click the project that you want to zip.
- Depending on the archive software you use you will see an instruction to either compress or add to an archive.
- Name the archive the same name as your project folder and select OK to create the zipped folder.
- Be sure to note where you are saving the zipped folder.
- Now that your project folder is zipped, you can submit the zipped folder to Dropbox for your assignment submission.
