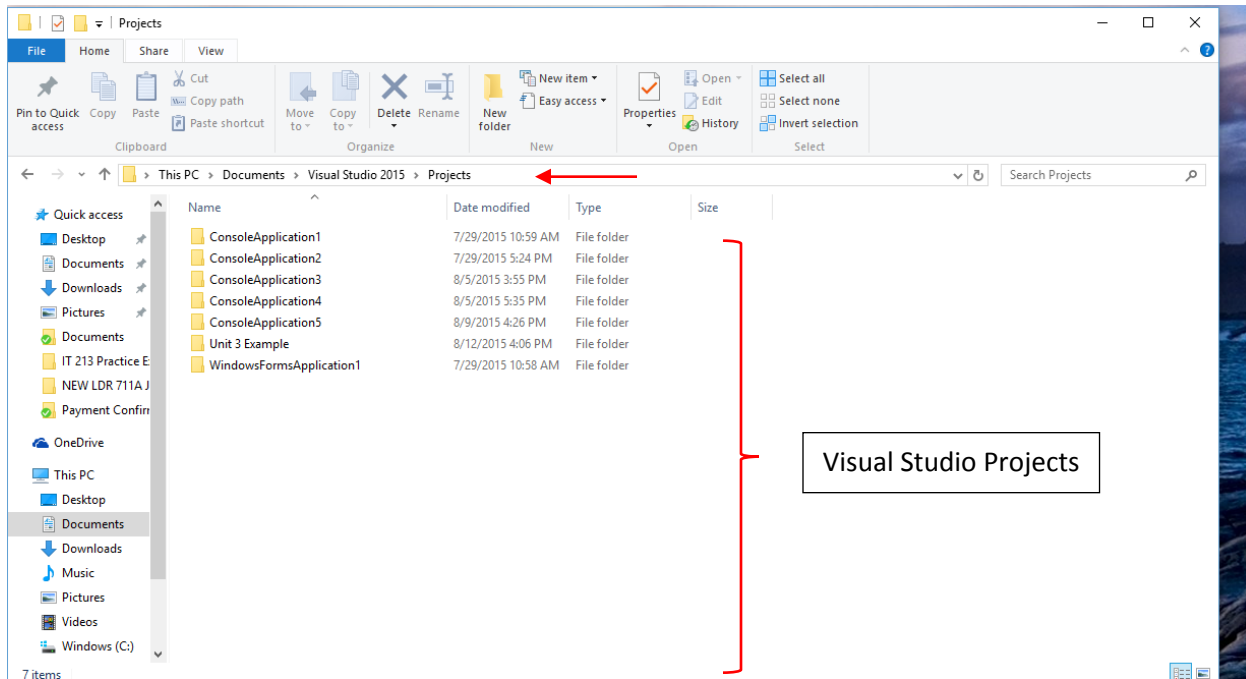


## How to Zip Your Visual Studio Project Folder

Visual Studio projects are saved in your Documents directory in the subdirectory, Visual Studio\Projects. This directory is typically found at Documents\Visual Studio YEAR\Projects. When you open the Projects folder you will see the projects that you have completed in Visual Studio.



- Highlight and right click the project that you want to zip.
- Depending on the archive software you use you will see an instruction to either compress or add to an archive.
- Name the archive or compressed file the same name as your project folder and select OK to create the zipped folder.
- Be sure to note where you are saving the zipped folder.
- Now that your project folder is zipped, you can submit the zipped folder to Dropbox for your assignment submission.
