

## MM207 Discussion Requirements

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Each discussion assignment offers students an excellent opportunity to share, compare, discuss, evaluate, and investigate responses for a deeper understanding of course concepts.

The following is a quick reminder of the general discussion assignment rubric-based requirements:

- Be active throughout the entire unit. Try to make your initial post early in the unit to give yourself the opportunity for feedback and corrections and to give your classmates an opportunity to respond and collaborate.
- Contribute to the discussion by sharing knowledge, creating a community, asking questions, helping others, and posting at least two substantive peer replies that incorporate content and move the discussion forward.
- Use course material, unit topics, textbook references, and scholarly publications to support and explain your ideas, posts, and responses. Do not forget to properly reference any resources that you use.
- To assure that you are actively participating and contributing to the Discussion, try to post on multiple days throughout the unit. Be sure your posts are grammatically correct, spell checked, and fully answer all the questions asked with work shown when appropriate.
