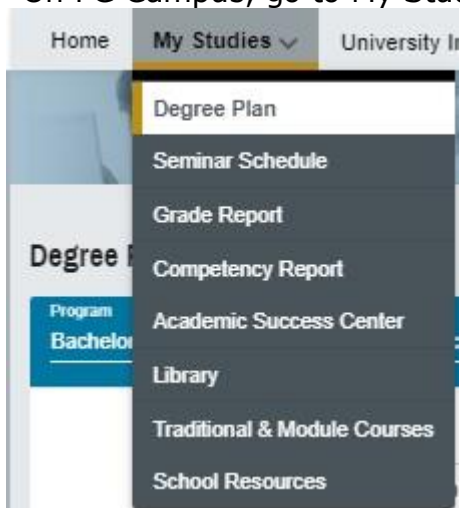
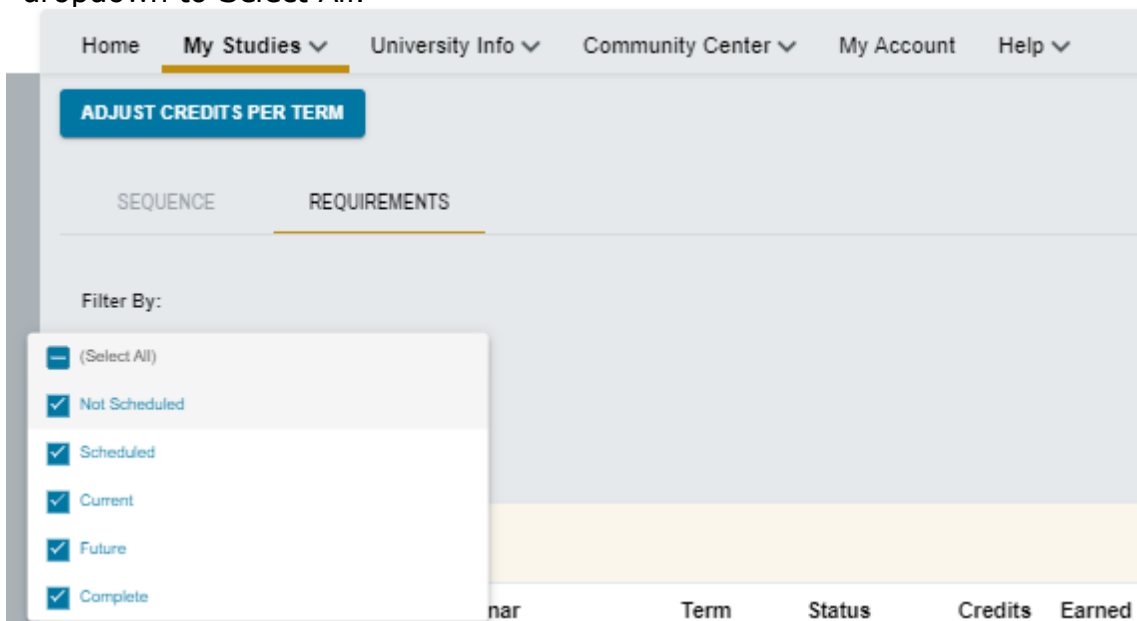


Blueprint Instructions




SC200: Discovering Science - Current Issues in a Changing World 5 ▼
