

Psychology Majors and Disciplines

The Bachelor of Science in Psychology in Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) degree offers the academic groundwork you will need to work successfully with people in a variety of settings. The program prepares you for continued graduate study, as well. Students explore the design, analysis. and application of learning theories and behavioral principles. This major prepares you to pursue careers working with children and adults who need support to address behaviors ranging from difficulty with everyday social interactions to various disorders including autism spectrum disorders, and other mental health challenges.

The Bachelor of Science in Psychology in Addictions provides a framework for understanding the needs of those who struggle with Substance Use Disorders. Students gain knowledge of the major concepts, theories, research findings and historical trends in psychology. Course work explores assessment, prevention, intervention, treatment, and case management.

The Bachelor of Science in Psychology in Industrial/Organizational Psychology program centers on the psychology of the workplace. Students learn about how to evaluate behavior and mental processes while applying psychological principles to roles in business, government, and nonprofit organizations. Areas covered also include talent management, coaching, assessment, selection, training, organizational development, performance (i.e., improvement, management), and work-life balance.
