This is the explanation of the Equator Coffee Belt Map:

The countries closest to the equator that tend to grow coffee for export (i.e., zero degrees latitude or the horizontal axis) are as shown on the map:

Mexico and Central America along with most of South America (except Argentina, Paraguay, Uruguay, and Chile), parts of Africa (Congo, Kenya, Ethiopia, Tanzania, Uganda, and Gabon), Yemen, India, Thailand, Indonesia, Malaysia, and the Philippines. In New South Wales and parts of Queensland in Australia, coffee is also grown.
