

What is an Expository Essay?

An expository essay involves investigating a topic; analyzing what you find; and supplying a solution, suggestion, or information to address the problem or task; and supporting your position.

There are three parts to an essay:

Introduction: This first section provides an overview of what you hope to accomplish in the essay.

Main body: This middle section addresses the questions or tasks in the assignment with the rationale or support.

Conclusion: This last section summarizes your response to the assignment questions or tasks.
