What is an Expository Essay?

An expository essay involves investigating the topic, analyzing what you find, and supplying a solution, suggestion, or information to address the problem or task, and supporting your position.

There are three parts of an essay:

Introduction: This first section provides an overview of what you hope to accomplish in the essay.

Main body: This middle section addresses the questions or tasks in the Assignment with the rationale or support.

Conclusion: This last section summarizes your response to the Assignment questions or tasks.
