## RESPONSE TO INITIAL POST

Hey, Ted. Great job with your prewriting. I think you came up with some great topics. Wouldn't that mean your blog post would be really formal and research based, rather than personal and informal? What about that third topic? To me, that would be a great topic. What about writing to other parents who are also worried about this issue? Could you write to them and use your experience as a parent to help them keep their kids out of gangs?

Commented [JV2]: Notice that this response is constructive and very helpful. Makayla helps Ted to see that the first topic idea is too formal for the blog post assignment. She instead suggests that he choose another topic from his list and offers suggestions for a stronger audience and purpose more appropriate to the writing assignment.
