Example of Post 1: Initial Response

I have wanted to visit Russia for as long as I can remember. Now that my business, Magnolia Blossom Beauty, has many successful branches around the US, I have decided to open my first international branch in Moscow. I need to set prices for my items in Russian rubles.

Today (October 3, 2020), the exchange rate is 1 US Dollar = 78.19 Russian Ruble. [Include URL]

Daytime moisturizer: $\$15 = \$15 * 78.19 \text{ rubles/dollar} = 1,172.85 \text{ rubles}$

Nighttime moisturizer: $\$20 = \$20 * 78.19 \text{ rubles/dollar} = 1,563.80 \text{ rubles}$

Magnolia Blossom Youth Serum: $\$65 = \$65 * 78.19 \text{ rubles/dollar} = 5,082.35 \text{ rubles}$

Under-Eye Dark Circle Eraser: $\$45 = \$45 * 78.19 \text{ rubles/dollar} = 3,518.55 \text{ rubles}$

Rejuvenating Facial Mask: $\$50 = \$50 * 78.19 \text{ rubles/dollar} = 3,909.50 \text{ rubles}$
