Example of Post 2: Reply to a Classmate

I was recently traveling in Moscow for my job, and I came across a wonderful store called Magnolia Blossom Beauty. Their Rejuvenating Facial Mask is the best I've ever used, so I want to have four of them shipped to my home in the US. There is a 5% sales tax along with a \$100 shipping charge. How much will that be in US dollars and also in Rubles since I'm purchasing them in Russia?

Four face masks: \$50 * 4 = **\$200** (\$200 * 78.19 rubles/dollar = **15,638 rubles**)

Sales tax: 5% of \$200 = 0.05*200 = **\$10** (\$10 * 78.19 rubles/dollar = **781.90 rubles**)

Shipping charge **\$100** * 78.19 rubles/dollar = **7819.00 rubles**

Total cost in dollars: \$200 + \$10 + \$100 = **\$310**

Total cost in rubles: 15,638 + 781.90 + 7819 = 24,238.90 rubles
