

# Key Facts and Figures

## Winter Storm Astro

November 1-3, 2012 (48 hours)

Fire Department personnel were available to assist with public safety response including EMS, fire suppression, and management of accidents and fallen wires.

- 4 chief officers (x 12 hour shifts each at \$24/hour)
- 4 captains (x 12 hour shifts each at \$18/hour)
- 12 firefighter/paramedics (x 12 hour shifts at \$16/hour)

Police Department personnel were available to assist with public safety response, traffic control and securing isolated roads after closure.

- 4 shift commanders (x 12 hour shifts each at \$27/hour)
- 4 lieutenants (x 12 hour shifts each at \$20/hour)
- 8 officers (x 12 hour shifts at \$18/hour)

Public Works Department personnel were brought in to assist with snow removal, clearing of public roads, and removal of fallen tree debris to town dump.

- 4 supervisors (x 12 hour shifts at \$25/hour)
- 6 staff (x 12 hour shifts at \$15/hour)

Damage to city buildings, due to a roof that collapsed and pipes that burst after a furnace failed, is estimated at \$7500.

Damage to city parks is estimated to be approximately \$25,000 from damaged trees, benches, and playgrounds.
